# Home Alterations : Request for Approval

Per General Provision 7 of the Hampton Hills Homeowners Association Covenants, no building may be placed, altered or removed without approval. If you are planning property alterations that adjust the exterior footprint of your property, including additional structures such as sheds, decks and patios, please submit plans of alterations to the HOA Board at least 30 days prior to construction. Construction may begin only after plans have been approved in writing by the Developers Review Committee.
